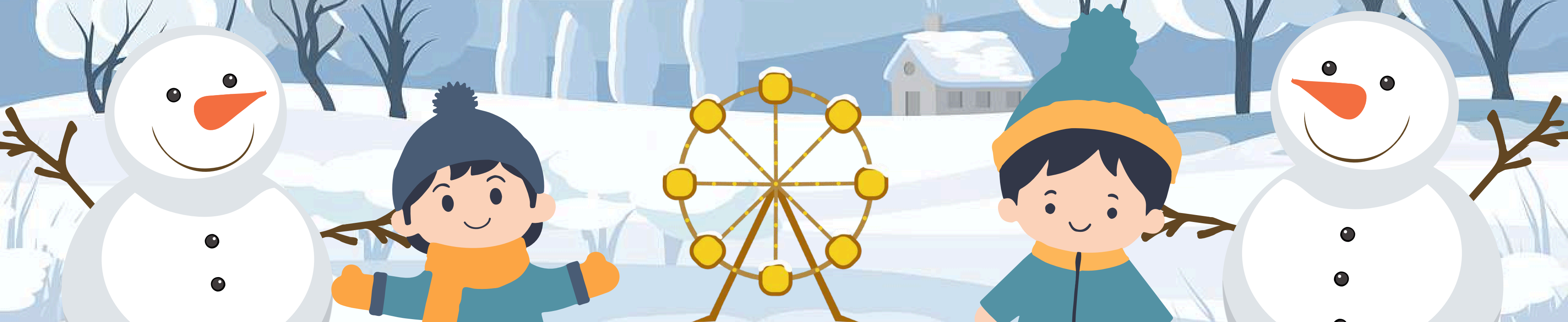

# *Breaking the Walls: Learning Beyond the Classroom*

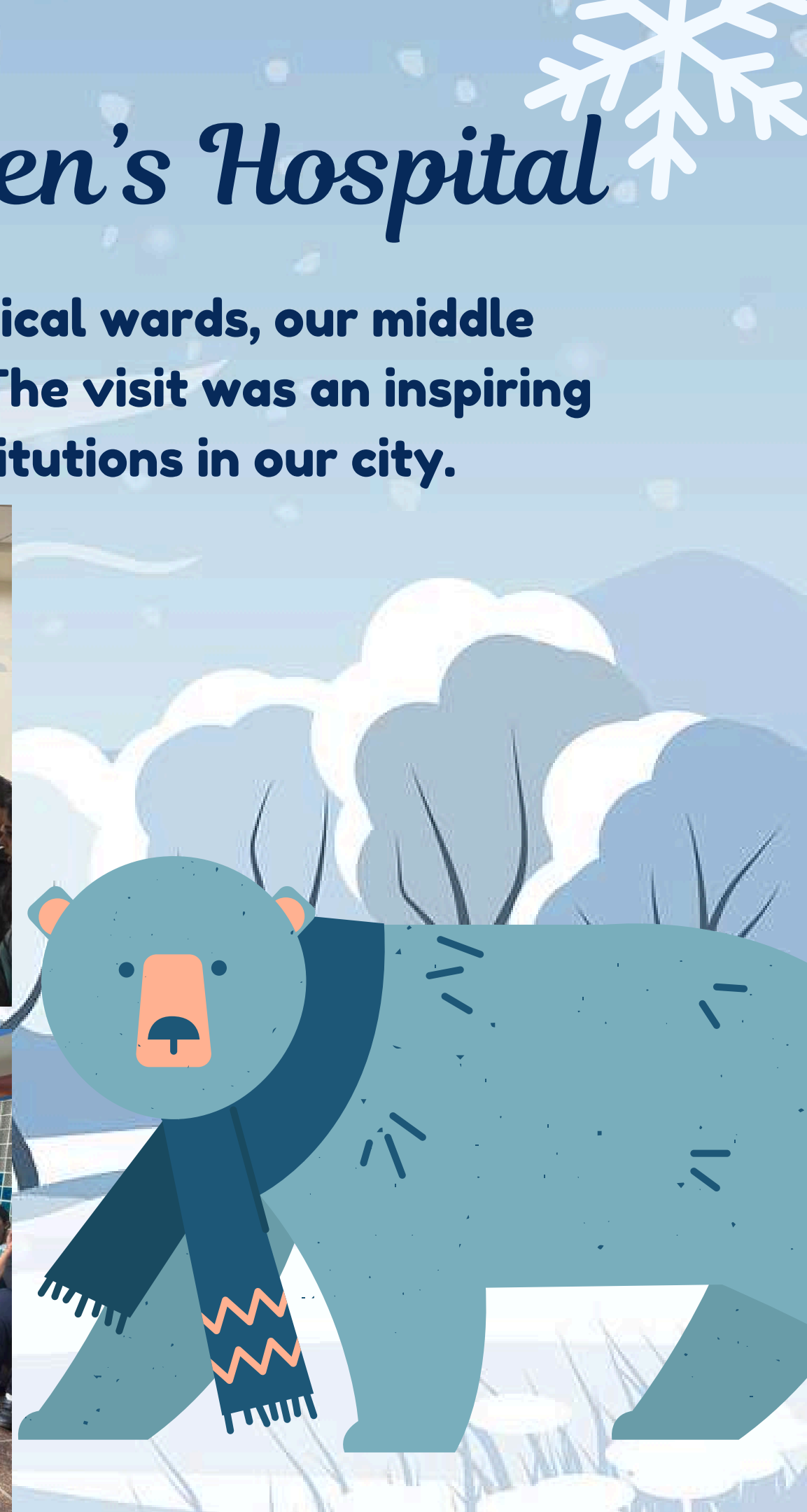

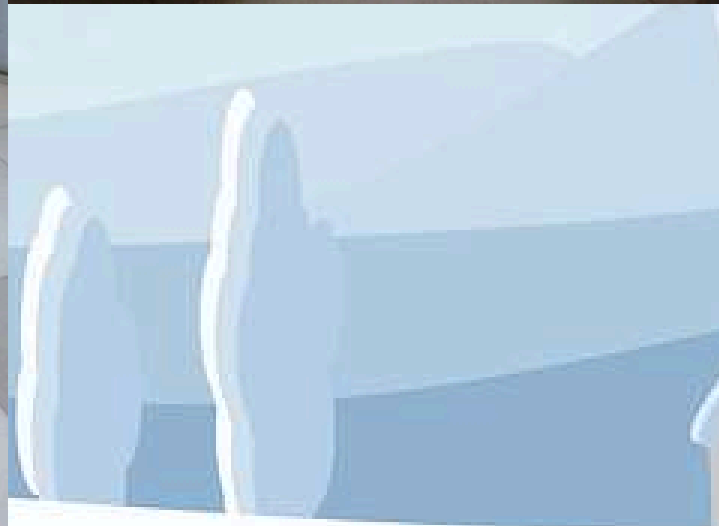
# Beyond the Books: A Learning Journey to MRR Children's Hospital

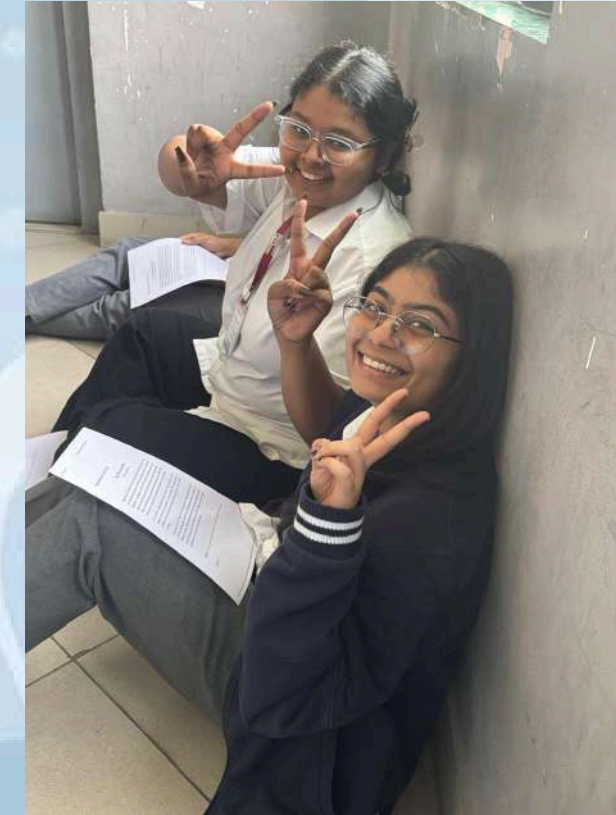
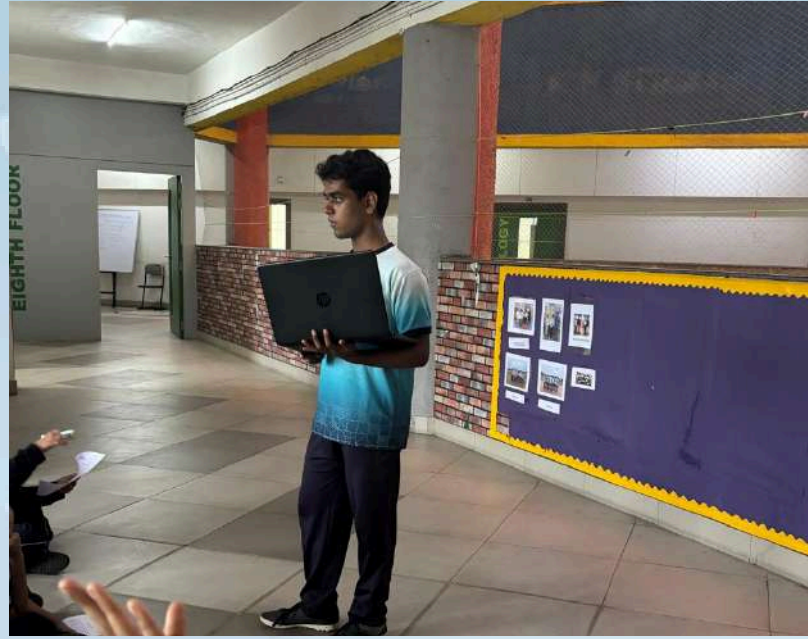
# *The Pillars of Democracy: Honoring our Constitutional Heritage*




# Empowering the Next Generation of Eco-Warriors

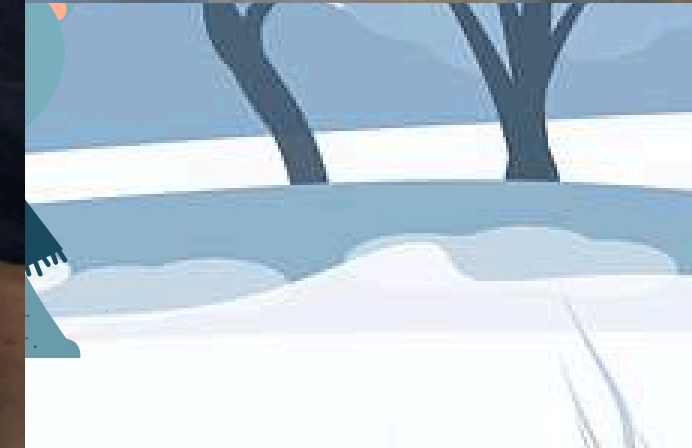
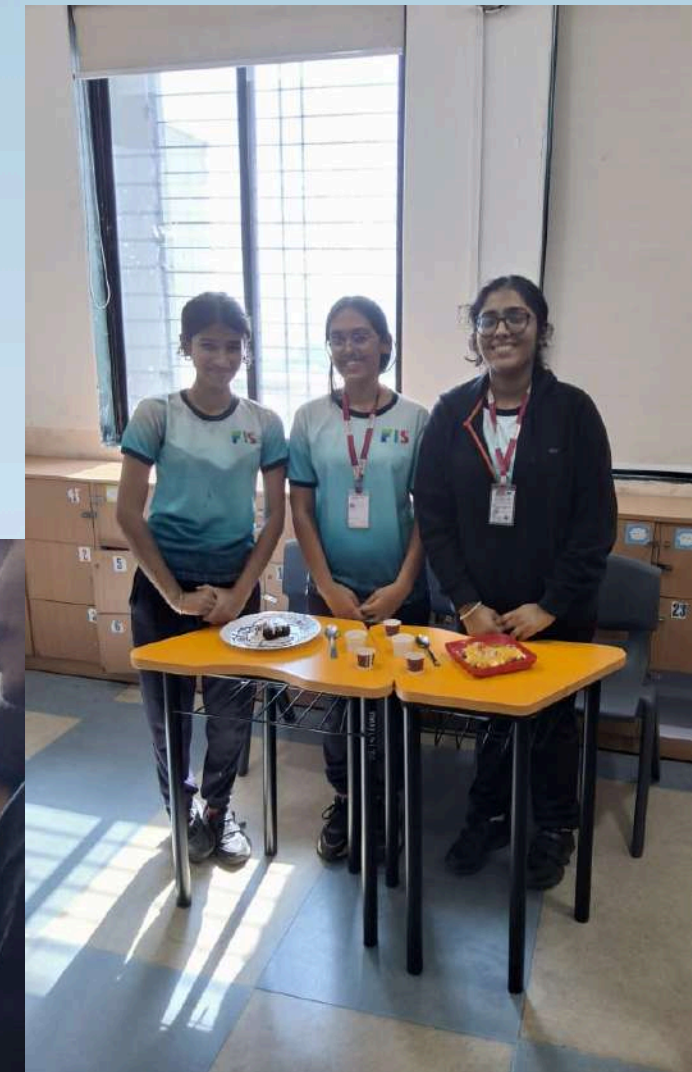
# *Post-Examination Review: PTM 17/12/25*
