AWARENESS SESSION ON BURN SAFETY



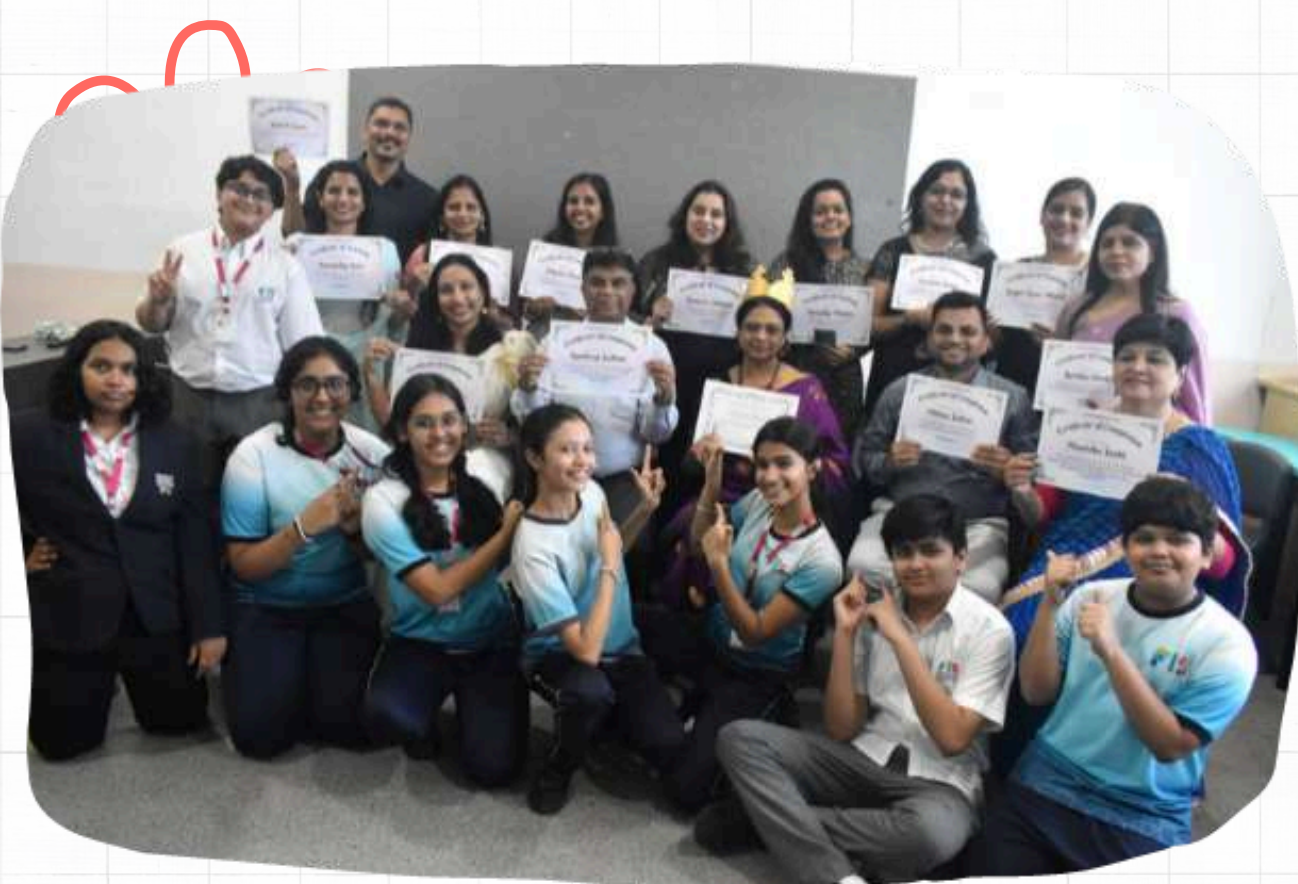

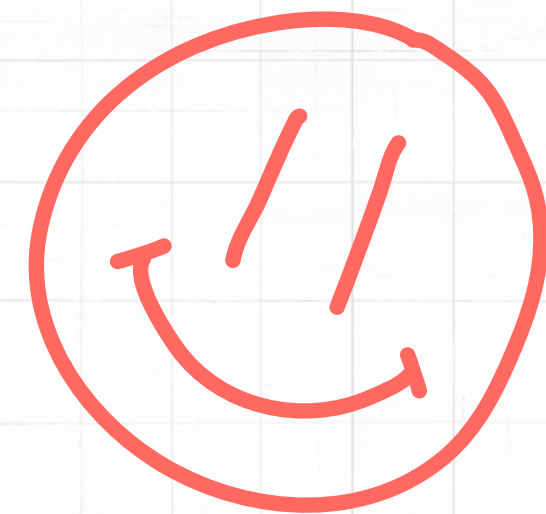
HP SMART CHAMPS S 1 QUIZ COMPETITION



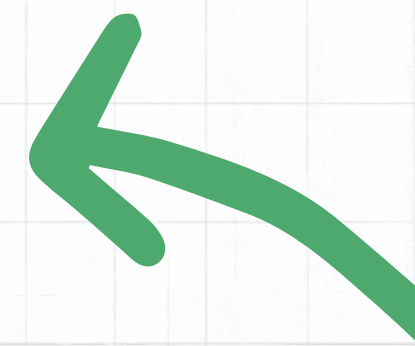

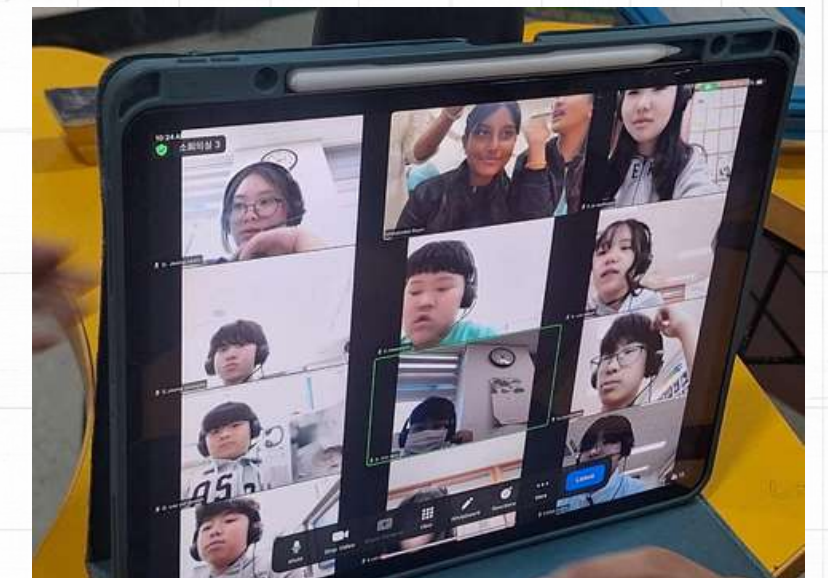
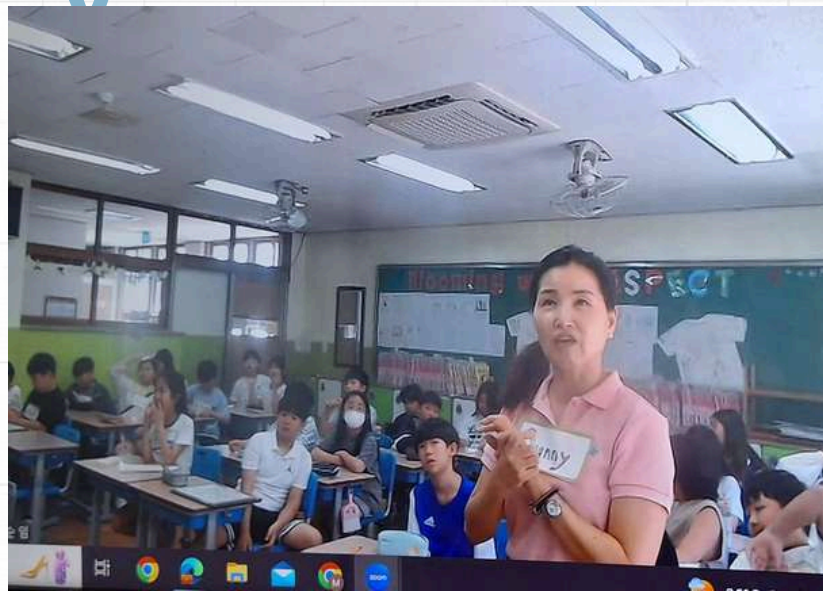


EXCURSION TO MYSORE AND OOTY

CULTURAL EXCHANGE MEET WITH KOREA



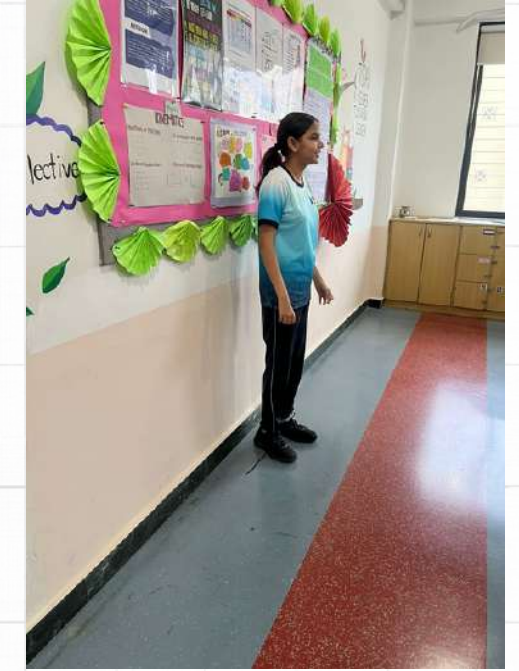
